Evangelism Update

For those who may be wondering what it means to participate in our local evangelism efforts, here is an overview of the Evangelism Ministry.

Evangelism Purpose:

The purpose of the Evangelism ministry is to train our members to look for and take advantage of every opportunity that comes our way to share our faith. The intent of this is to eventually hold bible studies with prospects so that they can come to a decision about Christ and, Lord willing, they will obey the gospel.

Activities

1. The Evangelism Ministry Team will meet monthly to discuss evangelistic opportunities and brainstorm how to approach each opportunity as effectively as possible. If there are new prospects, we will assign those studies to the appropriate team. Each team will pair an experienced person with someone in training. Each team will report on their assigned prospect to discuss how to learn from them.
2. We will coordinate with those who participate in the Barnabas Project regarding sending Compassion Cards, Visitor Gift Bags, and New Mover Buckets. This will ensure that no opportunity falls through the cracks.
3. We will also coordinate with the Benevolence Ministry Team to make sure that needs we become aware of are met.
4. We will continue to hold Open Home Ministry dinners and devos on a regular basis with those who have expressed interest in encouraging our visitors. We will invite them into our home and get to know them with the intent of studying the Bible with them.
5. We will also coordinate with the TALENTS Ministry to make sure that we do not disrupt what might already be in progress.

Motivation
