March Evangelism Update

We had a wonderful evangelistic campaign in Kailua, Hawaii, with three congregations involved in door knocking and inviting those who live near the church building to come to services. We had several visitors while we were there and two people ended up putting on Christ in baptism. One of them, Chris Lee, was baptized while we were there, and one Jana Dickson, was baptized the Wednesday after we flew back.

Both of these stories are interesting because Chris is 50, terminally ill, and had never obeyed the gospel even though he grew up in the church. His mom, Elda, is in her 70's and was wondering if her son would ever become a Christian. What an amazing example of a lifetime of answered prayers for her.

Jana is the daughter of Ben Guillermo, a man who has been preaching in Hawaii since the mid 1950's. He is 95 and Jana, is around 70. She, too, was raised in the church and had never obeyed the gospel. When Jana came out of the water after being baptized, Ben could be heard weeping and saying, "Finally."

Both of these examples are reasons for us to not give up on those we love that have not obeyed the gospel. As long as they are still alive and have their mental faculties, there is still hope. Please join me in rejoicing with Elda, Ben, Chris, Jana, and the church, in these two souls being united with Christ.
