Evangelism Update September 2023

About 8 months ago, Jamie Elkins received a call from a relative about her mother. Miss Faye had been a member at Gurley for several years and had recently been diagnosed with cancer. When her daughter found out that Miss Faye was uncertain about her understanding and repentance when she was baptized many years ago, the first person she thought of to call was Jamie. That is a direct result of her influence as a Christian on those around her. When tragedy stuck, they thought of Jamie, we should all want people to think of us when they have serious needs especially of a spiritual nature.

Jamie and I went to see Miss Faye and just talked. We talked about several things but what was really on her mind was her spiritual condition. We got around to talking about her uncertainty about her salvation. I read to her about the 12 disciples in Acts 19, who, when they found out there was something missing in their conversion story, made it right and sure by being baptized for the remission of their sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19).

Miss Faye immediately saw what I was teaching from the Bible. That if a person is not sure, there is an answer once they know that they know the truth. To be baptized after full and accurate teaching washes away the doubt just like it washes away the sin. That rebirth occurred on January 21st this year. This past Sunday, September 3rd, Miss Faye passed away.

The lesson for all of us is the same. Make your calling and election sure (2 Peter 1:10) while you have time and opportunity. Most of us probably knew exactly what we were doing, remember why we did it, and have no doubts about our eternal salvation. However, if you do, it can be resolved easily and with confidence that God will keep His promises.
