## **Evangelism Update**

I wanted to use my space here to remind everyone what it means to "Think Souls First". What I propose is a complete paradigm shift in our thinking which is no small task. We need, if we are not already doing so, to keep eternity in view for both us and those we are in contact with. That could mean family, friends, coworkers, or complete strangers (even enemies for that matter).

What does that look like in everyday life? There was a pretty good example of it in the book of Acts. If you remember from Chapter 7, Stephen was stoned to death for preaching the truth and beginning in Chapter 8 we read about a great persecution that came upon the church. It would have been easy for the early Christians to scatter and hide, but instead, they scattered and "preached the word" (v. 4). Can you imagine what faith and courage that must have taken? Run out of town, no home to call your own, scared for your life because of your faith, and you can't stop talking about Jesus. We should want to have that kind of faith, amen?

We have a great example of that right here at Chase Park. A few months ago, Angela Ireland started talking to me about a friend she has known for years whom she got to know when both of their sons were having similar health issues. They have kept in contact over the years. Angela's son tragically passed away a couple of years ago. When Kerry, her friend, had some difficulties, she messaged Angela and expressed concern because she was not sure she was saved. Angela asked her if she wanted to study the Bible to know for sure and Kerry said yes. They studied "Does It Matter" and when completed, Angela contacted the preacher in Baytown, Texas that was referred to me from friends in the church. That preacher, Trent, baptized her into Christ a week or so ago.

Angela could have given up on God when extremely difficult times came, many people do. But instead, it caused her to double down on her relationship with God and become even more involved with evangelistic efforts. She was "Thinking Souls First" and wanted her friend to know what she knows, that Jesus died for all and could wash away her sins, which He did on June 28<sup>th</sup>.
