The Faith of Isaac

We often talk about the faith of Abraham, but have you ever thought about the faith of Isaac, his son?

Isaac was the son born to Abraham and Sarah in their old age. He was the promised one through whom many nations would come. He was the one through whom the Savior would come.

Genesis 17:19. "But God said, 'No, but Sarah your wife will bear you a son, and you shall call his name Isaac; and I will establish My covenant with him for an everlasting covenant for his descendants after him.'"

Genesis 22:1-2. "Now it came about after these things, that God tested Abraham, and said to him, 'Abraham!' And he said, 'Here I am.' Then He said, 'Take now your son, your only son, whom you love, Isaac, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I will tell you.'"

It's interesting that they arrived at the place for the offering on the third day. Just as Abraham was a representation of God the Father, Isaac was a representation of Christ. Christ was raised on the third day and figuratively Isaac would as well.

As the two approached the place for the offering, Isaac pointed out that they had brought the fire and wood, but no lamb for the offering. Abraham responded, "God will provide for himself the lamb for the burnt offering, my son."

This was prophetic of what Christ would do in offering Himself as our lamb. But don't lose sight of the fact that Isaac watched Abraham build the altar, arrange the wood, and then he allowed his father to bind him and lay him on the altar.

We know that the angel of the Lord called to Abraham and stopped him from killing Isaac. He set him loose and instead offered the ram caught in the thicket.

So just as Christ bore His cross to Golgotha, Isaac carried the wood for his offering. Although there was a definite plan on Christ's part for His own death, Isaac submitted himself to the will of Abraham. His love for his father was strong enough that he allowed Abraham to tie him up and lay him on the altar.

This story is very helpful to us in demonstrating what God did for us in giving Christ as our perfect Lamb. We can see the great faith of Abraham; but we also see the faith of Isaac.

As we consider the things that God has called us to do, our task is much less than what God asked of Abraham. And it is much less than what Christ did for all of us.
