For the last two months, I have been serving as the Chase Park youth intern. I have been attending camps, organizing events, and teaching classes. While at many points this summer I have been both physically and mentally exhausted, the job was a blast, and I am grateful to have had this opportunity. Here are a few highlights from this summer.

Vacation Bible School – With classes for kids in the morning and teenagers at night, VBS was an all-day ordeal. I especially enjoyed singing at the houses of shut-ins with the teenagers and singing the beloved “Hippo Song” with the kids.

Mission Trip – The youth group went to Montgomery and packed trucks with supplies to be sent to Ukraine. The work was hard, but rewarding, and the teenagers found plenty of ways to stay entertained during the workdays.

Rocket City Youth Camp – This is a youth camp for several congregations in the area, and it gives Chase Park students a way to interact with fellow Christian students. I co-taught the 3rd-5th grade class with Will, and I learned how tough it can be to hold the attention of forty 8-year olds.

Maywood – There is no place like Maywood Christian Camp. Being surrounded by nothing but Christians and trees for a week is incredibly spiritually edifying. More than 10 people were baptized that week, and I left feeling so much stronger than when I came in.
