

THERE IS HOPE in HIM

In 1 Corinthians 6:9-11, the Bible gives the true meaning of hope. "Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers nor men who practice homosexuality, "nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God." And such were some of you. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God." In this passage Paul is quick to point out that those who are unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God. We see that there are several examples of lifestyles that people have chosen that are against the will of God.

Too many times we hear the argument that our God is not a loving God or God has made me a certain way and I am unable to change. Such arguments are crushed when reading the passage above. For in verse 11, God shows his love by offering salvation and admittance into the kingdom of God if we are washed (baptized) into Christ. As a matter of fact, the Bible says in 1 Timothy 2:4, that God "desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth." We serve a God who desires to heal those who are spiritually sick (Luke 5:31). Our God is willing to take the sinner and their flaws and make a new creature within His family. Verse 11 of our passage says, "And such were some of you. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified." God gives us the hope of salvation if we only abide by His word. This hope is a forever promise and a guarantee that if we come to know God and are of His kingdom then we will be with Him in Heaven. I am joyful to be part of a family who has such a loving Father.
