Outreach News—Pat Cowden

We are coming up on the Holiday season, which is a time for joy and fellowship for most, but for others it can be a time of great depression. We need to make a concerted effort to reach out to those, both inside and outside of the church, who may be dealing with silent issues. This is the perfect time of year to begin the habit of showing people that you truly care for them. This is a fundamental step in developing lasting and real relationships with others. These relationships are the building blocks of a successful evangelistic plan for a local congregation.

We all understand that God wants us to reach out to others (Mark 16:15-16; Matthew 28:19-20). The question for many is, how? How do I get started? What do I say? What if they say no? What if they get mad? What if I loose a friend or a relationship? Although these are all feelings we may have at times, they are not a good enough reason to withhold the gospel from the lost. Jesus was clear that His expectation is that we talk to others about Him (Mark 10:32-33).

One of the things that helped me grasp the gravity of this situation was when we lived in Saipan. Saipan is a small island about 4 miles wide and 12 miles long. The realization I had and shared with the Christians on Saipan was this: If you and I do not share the gospel with the people of Saipan, who will? The answer of course is, no one will because no one else would be sharing the truth that makes people free (John 8:32). Who do you know that might not know anyone else but you that can lead them to Christ? Pray for them.

Evangelism challenge:

We had over 30 people come out to help with door knocking, and doing project work during Monday Night for the Master. It is a wonderful way to fellowship with your brothers and sisters and to do good for others. Please make an effort to involve yourself in this effort, which is usually on the fourth Monday night of each month.

Remember, I love you in the Lord and want to go to heaven with you.
