

Have you ever had the Vacation Bible School song, "He's Still Working on Me" come to mind? Thoughts along these lines come to mind because it's a catchy tune, but also because we realize we are humans striving to reach the holiness God desires of us. We live in a world where Satan is constantly tempting us, trying to pull us away from following our God. At times we may stumble, but we should be encouraged by Paul's words to the Corinthians, 2 Corinthians 7:1 – "Having therefore these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God."
