# **Against All Odds**

In 1 Kings 17:8-16, we are introduced to a widow and her son living in a difficult time. A great drought had swept through the town of Zarephath and the situation was dire. In verse 12 we read how the widow had only a handful of flower remaining for her and her son. This little flour would serve as their final meal as they believed death would soon follow.

Elijah, the great prophet of the Old Testament who also found himself impacted by the great drought was told to seek out the widow and her son at Zarephath. Once Elijah arrives, he asks for the widow to share the last their water and food. As difficult as this request may have sounded the widow agrees. What should have been their last meal is shared with a stranger.

Although the odds were against them, this poor widow placed her trust and faith in the Lord and his great prophet. As a result of her kindness, we read in verses 14-16 that her oil and flower would never run out... God provided.

Reflect upon your life, have you ever faced a time/s where the odds were against you? Did worry or fear come upon you? If so, did you think to pray and ask God to guide you through the situation or challenge? The widow and her son were in a situation they could no longer control. Their food and water supplies were exhausted. Yet their faith and trust were in the Lord, and he guided them through the situation
