Chase Park Evangelism Update April 2024

Happy Mother's Day to all our mothers at Chase Park. We are blessed by having you in our lives and want you to know we love and appreciate you so very much. Once per year is probably not adequate to show our gratitude for all that you do. I hope your family will make it a special day for you.

You might be wondering how that fits with an article about evangelism at Chase Park. One special role that mothers have is the special relationship God intends for them to have with their children. There are four words in the Koine Greek that are translated "love" in English. One of those words is {storge} which refers to the love a mother has for her child. This is one of the strongest relational bonds there is and it plays a vital role in the upbringing and development of her children. This includes physical, emotional, and spiritual development.

You have probably heard the saying, "She who rocks the cradle, rules the world." Spiritually speaking there is no more important people for a young person's development and future faithfulness than their mother and father. This early development will either make the way easier or more difficult for the young person to become a child of God at the appropriate time. So, yes, honoring mothers is appropriate for a lot of reasons, one of which (and the most important) is that her role in leading her children to Christ.
