

Chase Park Evangelism Update April 2024 What do these names all have in common? Joe Shirley Shirley Ryan Christ Jana First Weston

All of them have been converted to Christ through the power of God and obedience to the gospel through the efforts of members of Chase Park and others in the last 120 days or so. Some of them are relatives, some are caregivers, some have been lifelong attendees of the services of the church of Christ, some of them were contacted through door-knocking, some just showed up at the church building, some are young, some are middle aged, some are older. All have had multiple members of the church involved in nurturing them as they went through the process of learning the gospel.

What's the point of this article?

First, for us all to understand that everyone's stories are different, and we really do not know and cannot judge whether someone will be receptive to the gospel or not. We need to be seed planters and not soul pickers. If we till the soil, water and plant, God promises to give the increase as He sees fit. (1 Corinthians 3:6)

Second, to make sure we all know that we can, if we will, have a part in helping someone come to Christ. 121 or so days ago, none of these people were headed in the right direction religiously (with the exception of Weston because of his godly parents and influences at Chase Park). The rest came out of situations that could very well have turned out a lot differently. Thanks be to God for their soft hearts and willingness to listen when they were invited to study the Scriptures. Thank God for people who were willing to share their faith with them. Only three of these ten were baptized by ministers of Chase Park, that means the rest were taught by others. That is the definition of a healthy congregation that is intentional about *Thinking Souls First* by "seeking and saving the lost." (Luke 19:10)
