**“What the World Needs Now Is...”**

If you are old enough, when you read the title, your mind probably finished with, “Love, sweet love.” That song was originally sung by Jackie DeShannon in 1965, and has been covered by many other artists including Dione Warwick, Burt Bacharach, the Supremes, and Luther Vandross. The sentiment of the title is hard to argue with; the world, indeed, needs more “love”.

In our Wednesday morning Super Seniors class, we have been studying from 1 John which has a lot to say about love. We talked this week about how the Apostle John applied the “mother of learning” (repetition) liberally regarding love. One major point that we also talked about a week or two ago is how different the world views “love” compared to God.

There are four words in the koine Greek that are translated “love” in English. The fascination that the world has with physical love between a man and a woman, eros in the Greek, is not used one time in the New Testament. However, the words, agape and phileo, words addressing how we love our fellow man and our brothers and sisters in Christ are used dozens of times. It seems that, if repetition is the “mother of learning”, we should learn something from that.

Starting yesterday with Melissa’s lessons and beginning today with Scott’s we have a wonderful opportunity to learn how to “love” and raise our children and how to have faithful homes. If I were to rewrite the song, I would probably title it, “What the World Needs Now is Loving, Faithful Families.” Not real lyrical, but really is what the world needs now.

Remember, I love you and want to go to heaven with you.
